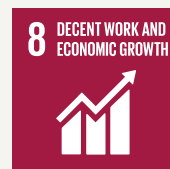
Youth@work assists South African companies to optimise B-BBEE points for qualifying spend through the YES programme.

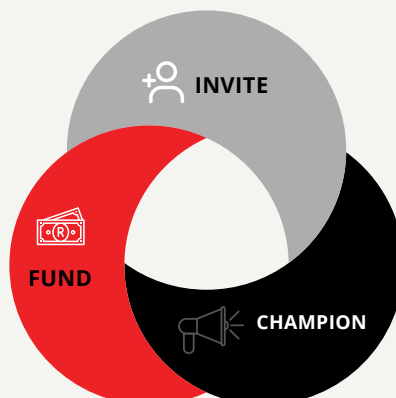
